## What You Need To Know About Nursing Center Admissions Right Now

With hospital policies decreasing the length of stay for patients, admissions for the nursing center are changing every day. We are accepting more complex medical cases and this is turning nursing centers into mini hospitals. Nottingham Village Senior Living Community has a 121 bed skilled nursing center which includes a short term rehab area designated for residents to either rehab and return home or to enter an assisted level of care.

Under the Medicare guidelines, one must meet the criteria of a three day hospital stay to qualify for Medicare benefits at any nursing center. Medicare HMO's, and other insurances, need to give authorization for skilled care.

Under skilled services we offer physical, occupational and speech therapies., IV antibiotics, wound care, feeding tubes, chest tubes and ostomy care.

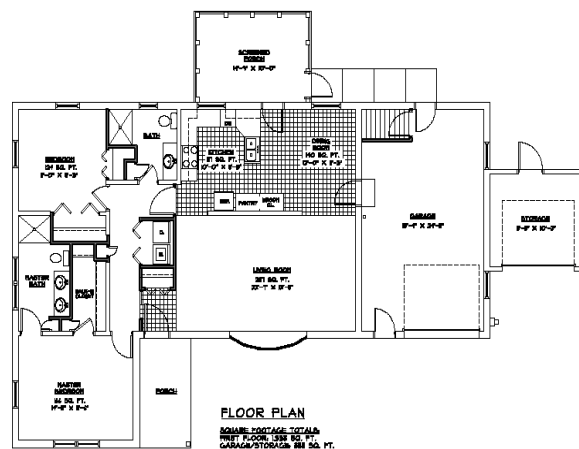

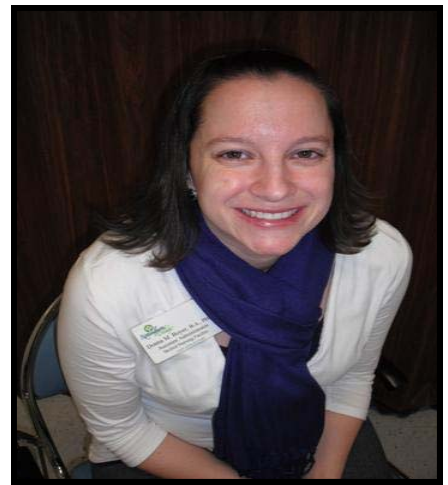
## GREAT NEWS FOR NURSING CENTER

Donna graduated from The College of William and Mary with a Bachelor’s Degree in 2004. She was born and raised in Virginia and moved to Pennsylvania in 2007.

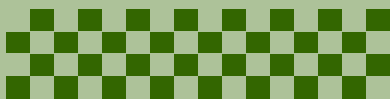

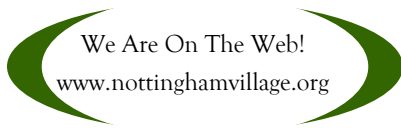
